The Community Youth Work Team provides a diverse range of inclusive and engaging services for young people aged 11 to 19, and up to 25 for those with additional needs or disabilities.

Our work focuses on supporting young people with their personal, social, emotional and educational development, while promoting social inclusion and active participation in the community.

Focus on Partnership working - Support and strengthen our local youth engagement and broaden our impact.


